Here is a selective listing by critics of The Times of new or noteworthy art, design and photography exhibitions at New York City museums and art galleries this weekend.

TANYA MARCUSE, Yoshii Gallery, 20 West 57th Street, (212) 265-8876 (through Feb. 28). Ms. Marcuse makes her small, exquisitely delicate photographic works by transferring the translucent emulsion from Polaroid prints to sheets of glass. Muted in color, wrinkled, misshapen and torn, they are like faded flower petals. In some, a blurry, female nude or ghostly face emerges; others appear entirely abstract (Johnson).
